We are not to fear There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. John 4: 18

We should not speak bad about our president and government officials 2 Peter 2: 10 ...walk after the flesh .. despise government. ..not afraid to speak evil of dignities. Jude 1: 8 ...filthy dreamers ... **despise dominion,** and **speak evil of dignities.**

How speak to Satan Jude 1: 9 Yet **Michael the archangel,** when **contending with the devil** he disputed about the body of Moses, **durst not bring against him a railing accusation,** but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

It is a growing thing

As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: 1 Peter 2: 2

For **every one that useth milk** is unskilful in the word of righteousness: **for he is a babe** Hebrews 5: 13

Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? **them that are weaned from the milk,** and drawn from the breasts. Isaiah 28: 9

For **precept must be upon precept,** precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: Isaiah 28: 10
